All exhibits of flowers, fruit and vegetables must have been grown by the exhibitors with the exception of classes $142,143,178,182 \& 183$.
Exhibits in classes $128,129,130,131$ and 179 must have been
cultivated by the exhibitor for a minimum of at least 10 weeks prior to the show.
Exhibits in home made preserves, drinks, cookery, handicrafts, sweets and the children's section must have been made by the exhibitor.
It is FREE to enter the show, no fee is charged.
No more than 3 exhibits per person PER CLASS, please.
Children may enter any class in the Show as well as their own division.
All exhibits and entries must be brought to the Show between 8.30-11.00am on Saturday 11 th September.

Exhibitors must bring plates, vases and containers. Water will be made available.
All exhibitors must leave the exhibition tent before Judges make their awards. The judging of exhibits will take place from 12 noon and the judges decision is final.
The show will open to the public at approximately Ipm. Any trophies or certificates will be awarded at the discretion of the judges.
A Prize giving ceremony will take place at 3 pm. All 1 st Prize winners will receive a medal and a certificate and all second prize winners will reecive a certificate. Cups may be available on the day. The exhibits must not be removed from the show at least until after the prizes have been awarded and displayed, preferably after 4.30 pm .
